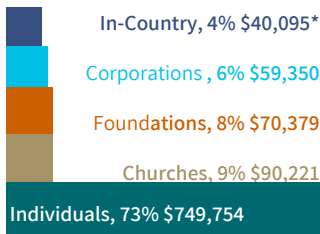

2020 Revenue

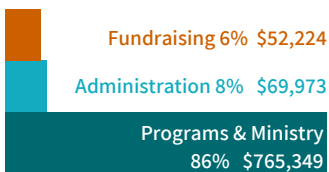
Total Revenue = \$1,009,799

YEAR IN REVIEW - 2020

Challenges

The Coronavirus pandemic affected each of our ministries in similar ways. With governmental shut downs, many of our programs were put on hold in 2020 while the COVID-19 virus dramatically impacted lives. Children in our Haiti and Zimbabwe programs continued to receive food but some adjustments were made, including providing food kits versus cooked meals in Haiti. Continued economic and political unrest in all four countries forced some programs to shut down for a time until violence was less threatening. Burkina experienced continued extremist violence, forcing our Mobile Clinic to eliminate outreaches in 2020. Haiti endured violence due to political unrest and kidnappings. Zimbabwe and Zambia continue to face significant economic and political challenges. Due to the pandemic and in-country violence CWO did not have any short-term teams traveling to serve in 2020.

Joys

With the challenges of the pandemic came opportunities for ministry to adapt, grow and serve others. We are most grateful that our entire staff is safe and healthy. Both the vocational school students in Burkina Faso and Haiti learned to sew face masks, providing them with a new skill and a way to make money for the ministry. Ministry leaders found unique and impactful ways to serve others in their communities. Pastors in Zimbabwe were given additional food for their families, and Our Kids caregivers were given additional food as well as hygiene supplies to help families stay healthy during the pandemic. Pastors in Haiti learned to reach out into their communities while sharing the Gospel. Leaders in Burkina Faso were able to show love and support to families who suffered loss during extremist violence. The young men in Zambia have still been learning and encouraged in their faith. We are grateful for God's provision and protection!

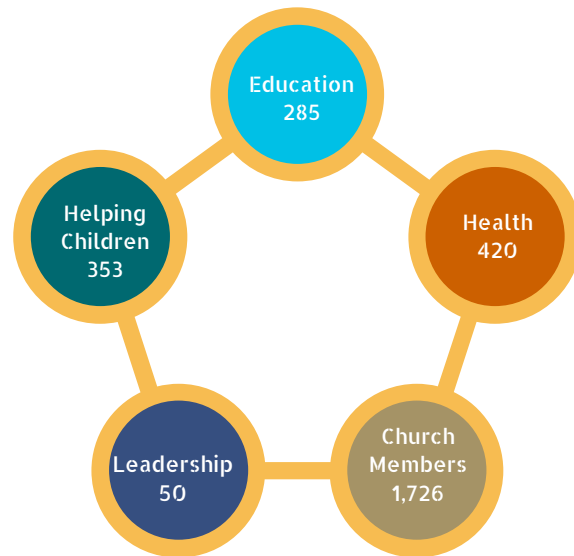
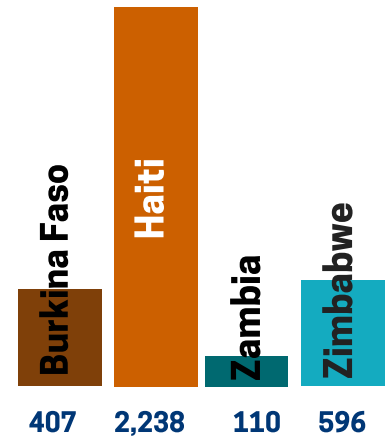
