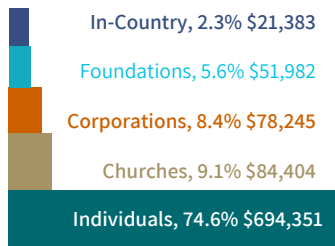

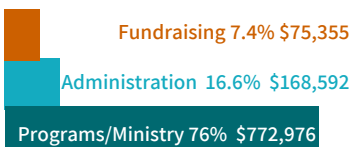
2023 Revenue

Challenges

Violence, persecution against Christians and economic instability continue to be our greatest challenges in the countries where CWO serves. Burkina Faso deals with extremist violence daily, Haiti's gang control continues to grow, single mothers in South Africa struggle to feed and care for their families, increasing negative responses toward Christians remains high in Sri Lanka's and Zimbabwe's ever-changing leadership creates uncertainty. While CWO leaders remain strong and passionate in their desire to share Christ with their communities, many of those they serve are fearful of their Christian ties being found out by others. We continue to pray for God's protection and guidance in these difficult places where we serve. He remains faithful!

Joys

Although our challenges are constant, it is the joy that motivates CWO to reach out to more people in more ways. Teachers and pastors in Haiti live under threat of violence, yet they serve their communities in mighty ways. Construction began on projects in both Burkina Faso and Zimbabwe. The Single Moms Raising Sons ministry has made numerous partnership connections to meet the expanding need of single moms and their sons. Our leaders in Sri Lanka completed a small construction project to help more children in the After School Program. With a focus on young girls in Zimbabwe and the popular Goat Project, ministry is making a difference. Transformation happens every day in ministry... whether it's feeding a child, watching a young woman see her worth in Christ or church leaders learning new ways to serve. God is good!

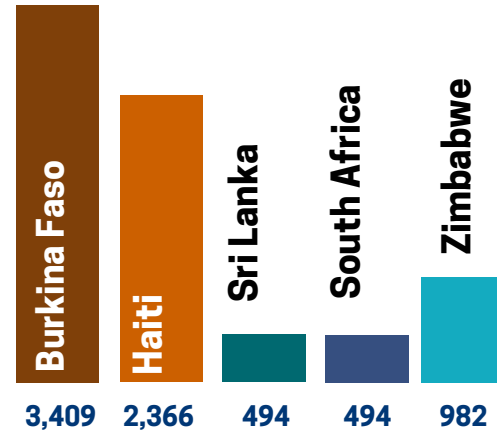

In 2023, CWO directly impacted 7,745 lives in Burkina Faso, Haiti, South Africa, Sri Lanka and Zimbabwe. Here is our impact by ministry and by country:



PEOPLE

- US - 3 staff members, 9 board members

- ZIMBABWE - 14 staff
